## Information about our fees from 1 July 2023

Please see the table below regarding expected gaps on common consultation items.

The practice is able to **facilitate instant Medicare rebates** using the Tyro system. To utilise this service, please bring a savings card (linked to a savings or cheque account) when you visit. The system enables payment in full at the time of the visit with your Medicare Benefit deposited back into your account instantly. Alternatively, if you have registered your bank details with Medicare, we can make an online claim on your behalf. For further information, please speak with one of our reception team members.

**Pension card and Healthcare card holders** will generally be charged a **discounted rate** as listed above, however this remains at the discretion of the treating doctor. Further fees apply for procedures and when materials are used.

**Results follow up.** It is practice policy for you to return to see your doctor for all test results. Consultations **for results only, may be charged at a reduced gap or bulk-billed** (at GP discretion) where the results and subsequent treatments are straight forward. For more complex follow up and treatment plans, regular fees will apply.

**Telehealth** services will attract a gap fee equivalent to the same length face-to-face service.

Please be aware that **gap fees will generally apply for all visits**. We understand that some patients may have been previously bulk-billed and will now be charged a gap. Please speak with reception if you have any concerns or if you have questions regarding our fees.
